INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is **Langdale Church of England School**
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is **"The governing body of Langdale Church of England School"**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
5. Total number of governors 12
6. The term of office for all categories of governors is four years
7. The Foundation governors are appointed by the Diocesan Board of Education, after consulting the PCC of the ecclesiastical parish in which the school is situated.
8. (a) The Holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:
The Principal Officiating Minister of the ecclesiastical parish in which the school is situated
- (b) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall appoint a

foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.

9. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
10. A trust exists for the school.
11. Langdale Church of England School provides education in accordance with the principles and practices of the Church of England. Worship, religious education and spiritual development are at the heart of every aspect of the work of this school.
12. This instrument of government comes into effect on 17 March 2015
13. This instrument was made by order of Cumbria Local Education Authority on the 23rd day of June 2015
